NATIONAL ACADEMIES OF PRACTICE INDUCTS Fran Weiss, LCSW-R, BCD, DCSW, CGP

The National Academies of Practice is pleased to announce the election of Fran Weiss, LCSW-R, BCD, DCSW, CGP of New York, NY as a distinguished practitioner-member of the NAP. Ms. Weiss was installed at a gala membership banquet on March 26, 2011 in Arlington, Virginia at which the National Academies of Practice inducted new members from ten healthcare professions.

The National Academies of Practice was founded in 1981 in recognition of the need for interdisciplinary collaboration in healthcare. It is comprised of distinguished practitioners and scholars from all of the primary health professions now including ten disciplines: Dentistry, Nursing, Optometry, Osteopathic Medicine, Medicine, Psychology, Podiatric Medicine, Social Work, Veterinary Medicine, and Pharmacy. Only 150 distinguished members can be elected to membership, so selection is indeed an honor. Each year, the NAP sponsors a Forum on public policy issues. This year's meeting focused on achieving interdisciplinary care. The NAP will issue a public policy statement on this topic shortly.
